Things to remember...

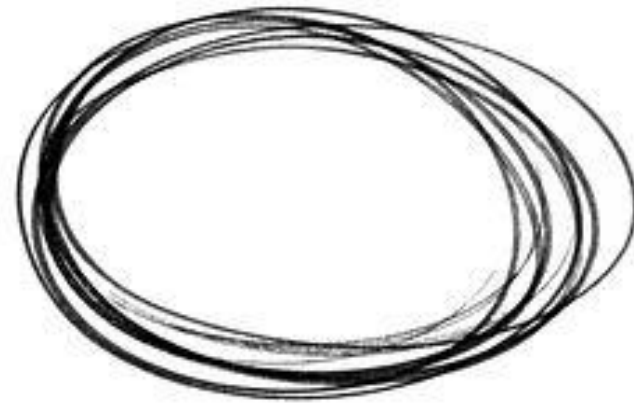
- Fill the canvas / paper.
- Use vertical brushstrokes only.
- Use blue, green and white only.
- Overlap the colours to blend them.



PAINTING- STAGE 2- LILY PADS

Things to remember...

- Practise sketching / painting the loopy ovals first...



- Use yellow, pink and white paint only...



PAINTING- STAGE 2- LILY FLOWERS

Things to remember...

- Start from the bottom of the flower and grow the petals upwards.

- Use red, orange, yellow and white paint only.

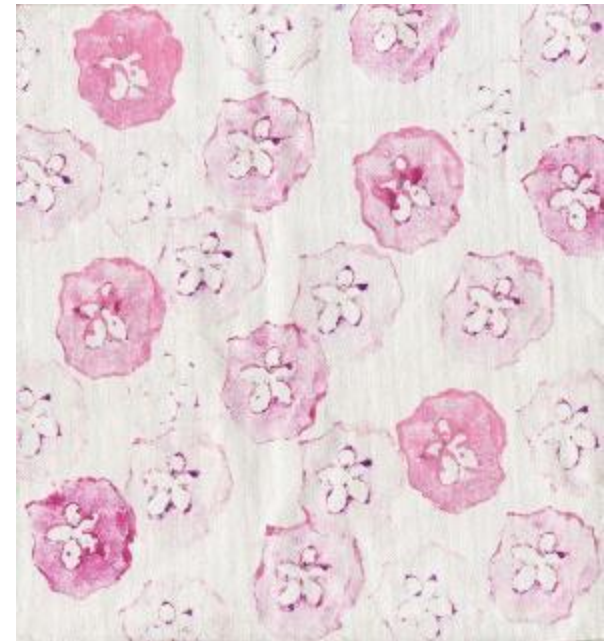
- try all of the vegetables
