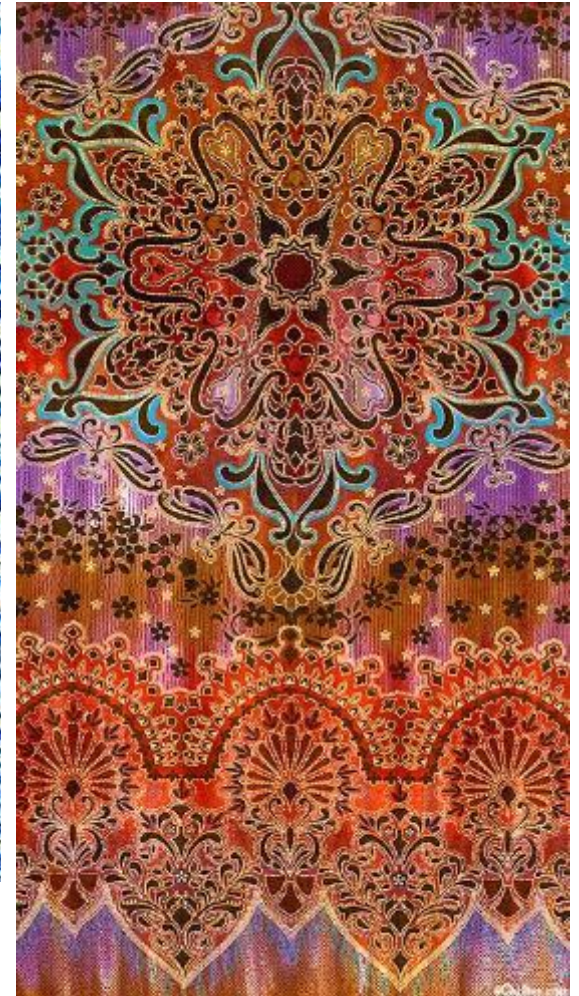

CREATE A DRAWING OF AN INDIAN PATTERN

Things to remember...

- Sketch out the basic shapes first
- Add details
- Add colour



CREATE A WAX RESIST EXPERIMENT

Things to remember...

- Sketch your design VERY lightly using a yellow colour pencil
- Go over your lines with a wax crayon
- Use watercolour / ink to “flood” the gaps



CREATE A BATIK

Things to remember...

- Sketch your design VERY lightly using a yellow colour pencil onto the fabric
- Follow your lines with HOT liquid wax using a Tjanting tool or brush
- Allow the wax to cool fully before carefully applying ink to the fabric
- If it is not your turn to use the batik, you should finish / refine / do another drawing of an Indian Pattern
