Things to remember...

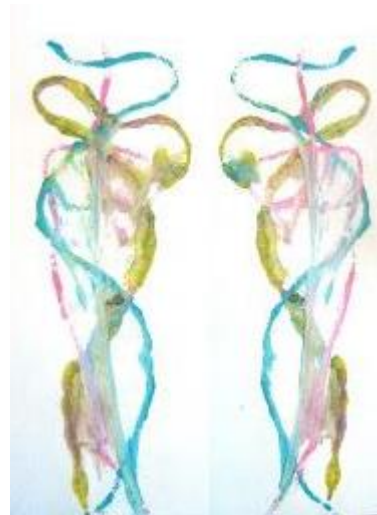
- Sketch basic shapes lightly first
- Keep your lines “fluid”
- Add as many details as you can see
- Add tone



CREATE A PULLED STRING PRINT

Things to remember...

- Fold your paper first
- Dip / paint the string
- Lay it on one side of your folded paper and keep the ends of the string sticking out
- Fold the paper and hold it down- use a book / card to help
- Pull the string while pressing down
- Open to reveal your print / painting

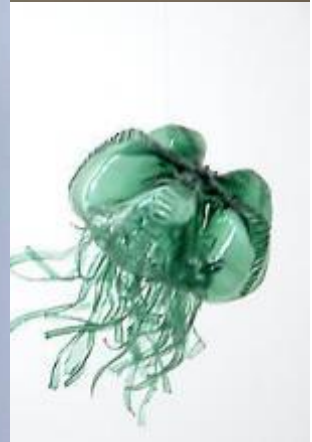
