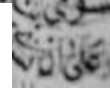
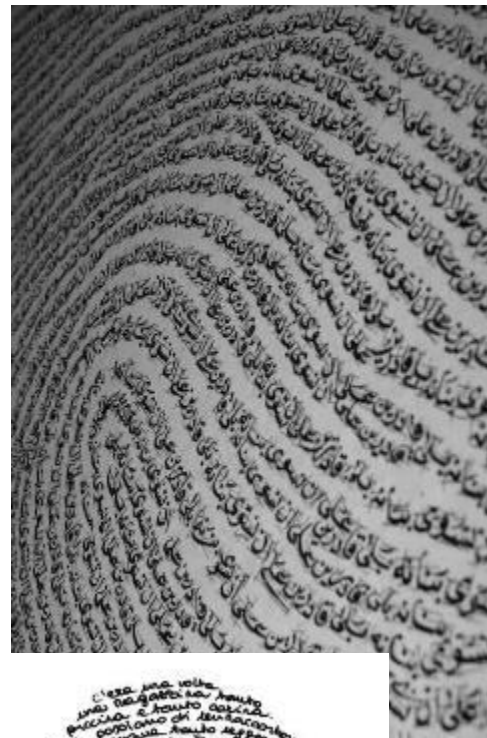

# CREATE A TYPOGRAPHIC FINGERPRINT

Things to remember...

- Look carefully at the pattern on your thumb
- Sketch the basic pattern as rows of lines
- Experiment with different languages, styles of font and size of font



# CREATE AN INK / WATERCOLOUR DRAWING OF A KOREAN TIGER

Things to remember...

- Sketch out the basic shape first
- Apply the orange ink / paint
- Then apply the black strips and features
- Start simple, then try more details



# CREATE A KOREAN TIGER PRINT

Things to remember...

- Simplified shapes, stripy pattern, curly tail
- Press down the areas you want to be white
- Apply enough ink to coat the poly-tile evenly
- Use a dry roller to push down your tile
